With the wet plate collodion process, there are a lot of chemicals and environmental factors at work. The imperfections of this process make each image unique and rare and cannot be duplicated in the same. Minor aberrations and imperfections will always exist in this process.

You will only be charged for the number of poses/images agreed upon prior to the sitting. The photographer will ensure that the images are acceptable within the limits of the process itself at the time of development. You will be able to witness the process and see the image as soon as it is developed.

Allow scheduling of approximately an hour per shoot. The process can be time intensive due to setup, lighting, processing, and developing each plate. More plates will require more time.

Due to the varnishing and preservation processes that are performed on the plate after the image is developed, it may not be possible to have all plates ready to take with you the day of the shoot. We will arrange delivery/pickup as soon as possible after the session.
